Description Fragment of a clipeus with an effigy of Medusa. The gadroons are

framed by a border of ovate leaves and a wider border of holm oak leaves and acorns. The corner flowers of the panel in which the figural composition is inscribed are composed of five petals with a central

undercut button.

A large part of the clipeo has been restored for installation in the

Museum.

The face is preserved except for the lower part of the neck area.
