Description Marble ballast, fragmented at the corners, with the effigy of Jupiter

Amon surrounded by a two-stranded cord that separates it from a

border of gadroons that surrounds the entire face.

It formed part of the sculptural decoration of the so-called "Forum Portico" or "Marble Forum", next to the "Temple of Diana" in the centre of Mérida. This decoration is a reflection of that created in the "Forum of Augustus" in Rome, serving as propaganda and adulation

of the figure of the emperor.
