Description

Spindle-shaped body, truncated cone-shaped foot with a tapering rim at the end, and a slender, curved neck. The upper part of the body has two decorative bands, the first with fleur-de-lis forming arches, and the second with vegetal scrolls. The handle is joined to the belly by a thickening in the form of a caratula; at the top, a foliate appendix.


